On March 21, 2019, the Congress of the state of Baja California Sur typified femicide as an autonomous crime in the penal code, with a penalty of 30 to 60 years in prison.

According to the RAE (Royal Spanish Academy), femicide is defined as the murder of a woman at the hands of a man due to machismo or misogyny.





24tons of garbage on beaches during Easter Week

During the **first week of Easter vacations**, which took place from March 28 to April 9, 2021, Zofemat collected garbage found on the beaches of the city of La Paz, reaching a total of **25,470 tons** of garbage, which represents a **decrease** of 49% compared to 2019. This could be a result of the 30% capacity allowed due to the sanitary contingency. Zofemat mentions that this year the citizens' participation was very important, seeing that they complied with the established regulations and people took most of the waste generated.
