## IN THE SPOTLIGHT

1

It was shown an increase of **94.8%** from 2019 to 2020, of **femicides** at the state level.

2

The municipality of **La Paz** presented the **highest rate of human trafficking** during the fourth quarter of 2020.

3

In 2020 were registered **229 files** of rape, and an average of **1 rape** every two days.

On March 21, 2019, the Congress of the state of Baja California Sur typified femicide as an autonomous crime in the penal code, with a penalty of 30 to 60 years in prison.

According to the RAE (Royal Spanish Academy), femicide is defined as the murder of a woman at the hands of a man due to machismo or misogyny.

In 2020 **BCS was above the national rate** by twice as many points in terms of rape.

In 2020 BCS was above the national rate by twice as many points in terms of **family violence**.

In 2020, **62 women** disappeared in BCS.

# Zofemat collects 24 tons of garbage on beaches during Easter Week

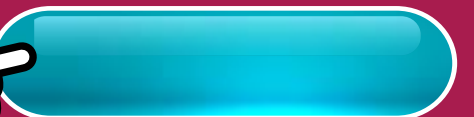


During the **first week of Easter vacations**, which took place from March 28 to April 9, 2021, Zofemat collected garbage found on the beaches of the city of La Paz, reaching a total of **25,470 tons of garbage**, which represents a **decrease of 49% compared to 2019**. This could be a result of the 30% capacity allowed due to the sanitary contingency.

Zofemat mentions that this year the **citizens' participation was very important**, seeing that they complied with the established regulations and people took most of the waste generated.
